



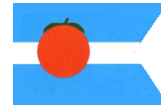

## ***Share the Fun of being a Member with a Friend! Application for Membership to LMVYC***

***Membership is open to members of the Lake Mission Viejo Association.***

### **Membership Categories:**

**Regular Members** receive an annual membership card which allows them to take advantage of our reciprocal program with other Southern California Yachting Association clubs. They have voting privileges in club elections, and participate in club activities and may serve on all club committees in which they have an interest. Regular membership includes entry fees for all our regattas, refreshments and food served after regattas; free rental sail boats (Expo 14.2) on regatta days, for Wednesday sunset sailing during daylight saving time and on Friday afternoons in July and August.

**Regular members are obligated to serve their turn as hospitality crew for two to three hours approximately once every two years.**

**Junior Members**, but no other family member may enjoy all the privileges of Regular membership except the right to vote or hold office. They may be appointed to serve on club committees. There are also certain age limitations on their use of rental and club boats.

**Associate Members** will receive an annual membership card which allows them to take advantage of our reciprocal program with other Southern California Yachting clubs. They will lose voting privileges, and may not serve on club committees. As associate members they do not attend our social events so they will no longer be obligated to serve as hospitality crew. However if they do wish to join us for the after race dinners, they will be welcome. They will be charged a guest fee of \$10 a person.

### **Membership Dues:**

There is an initiation fee of \$25 for new memberships.

The annual dues of \$85 for Regular and Associate membership are prorated depending on date of application. Dues are prorated quarterly for new members as follows, depending on the date of membership: Jan- Mar. \$25+\$85; Apr-Jun. \$25+ \$60; Jul-Sept. \$25+ \$40; Oct- Dec. \$25+ \$15. Thereafter, Membership dues are \$75 a year, payable annually in January.

**Junior Membership.** Children between the ages of twelve and twenty-one who are not part of a family membership may apply for their own separate Junior Membership with dues of \$25.00 per year.
