Beginning Sailboat Safety and Handling:

The four (4) safety and handling courses are designed for beginners (never sailed) and low intermediate sailors, and are limited to 12 sailors for each course. Each course consists of three (3) weekly two-and-one-half hour lessons on Wednesday afternoon, starting at 5:30 p.m. on the following dates:

All above mentioned courses are open to Lake Mission Viejo members, 16 years or older.

Beginning Sailboating for Juniors:

The three (3) courses are designed for beginners (never sailed) and low intermediate sailors, and are limited to six (6) sailors for each course. Each course consists of three (3) weekly two-hour lessons on Monday afternoons, starting at 5:00 p.m. on the following dates:

All above courses are open to Lake Mission Viejo members between the ages of 12 and 15 years, who are 95 pounds or heavier, and have good swimming skills.

Sailing Events at Lake Mission Viejo 1993

The Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club is bringing back great sailing to Lake Mission Viejo in 1993!

Coronado Invitational:

Beginning with the Coronado 15 Invitational Coast Cup Series in March, lake members will have the opportunity to participate or watch a great sailing event. This will include not only our own crews, but crews from eight other clubs from Santa Barbara to San Diego, and as far away as Phoenix. The fleets are separated into "A" and "B" fleets, with the "A" group featuring several national champions and the 1988 Olympic Gold Medal Winner! The "B" fleet will give some of our newcomers an opportunity to measure their skills.

This race is open to all Lake Mission Viejo members, but if you would like to be scored also under the 1993 Coast Cup Series, please contact Horst F. Weiler.

Monthly Regattas:

The first of the seven monthly sailing events is scheduled for March 28. The races are open to all Lake Mission Viejo registered sailboats. Five divisions from Novice to Advanced will compete for the top sailing spots. All scores are accumulated over the season to qualify for the final sailing event for the LMVYC Championship and Top Sailor "bragging rights".

Please mark these dates in your calendar (see list to follow). With the exception of the Coronado 15 Coast Cup, all regattas are held on Sundays. Registration is from 11:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m., with the Skipper's Instruction Meeting at 12:30 p.m., and the White Flag Start at 1:00 p.m. sharp.

Snacks and refreshments will be provided after the race at the club house. Entry fees for the Lake Mission Viejo regattas and the 16th Annual Regatta is \$8 each.

Sunset Sail and Wednesday Social:

Again in 1993, the Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club will hold the very popular Wednesday afternoon sunset sails, starting April 21 and continuing through September 29. The sailors start arriving at 5:30 p.m., with the first race "Red Flag" at 6 p.m.

After the last event, everyone meets for the traditional pizza and beer or soda at Emilio's Pizza, 23364 El Toro Road, in the Alpha Beta shopping center, facing Muirlands between Los Alisos and El Toro Road.

The Wednesday races will give the lake members the opportunity to participate in a low-key sailing event. Meet some of the Yacht Club Members, and get tips on setting up sailboats for racing, and improve your sailing skills.

16th Annual Lake Mission Viejo Regatta:

This is the highlight of our sailing season and always has a super turnout.

First place trophies are awarded in five fleets, and LMVYC commemorative T-shirts are given to all contestants who complete three races.

Club Championship Invitational:

The LMVYC Championship is the last of the year's scheduled events. It is by invitation only, but observers are encouraged to come join the fun. Points are accrued over the season by participation and placement. The regatta is sailed in 14-foot lake rental sailboats. The boats are sailed single-handed and are rotated following each race. This race will crown the Yacht Club Champion and their name is placed on the two-foot high perpetual trophy.

Winter Season:

During the non-sailing winter season, the club continues to meet every Wednesday night at 7 p.m. at Emilio's Pizza. Before the traditional Wednesday night social, Yacht Club members meet at Great Western Bank in the Market-on-the-Lake Center for a "keep-in-shape" walk around the lake. "Red flag" is at 6 p.m. sharp.
