Beginning Sailboat Safety and Handling

The five sailboat safety and handling courses are designed for beginners (never sailed) and low intermediate sailors, and are limited to 8 sailors for each course. Each course consist of three weekly 2 hour lessons on Wednesday afternoon starting at 5:30pm on the following dates:

March 7 - Coronado 15 Invitational Coast Cup Series

It will give the the lake members the opportunity to pariticipate or watch a great sailing event which will include not only our own crews but crews from 8 other clubs from Ventura to San Diego and as far as Phoenix. The fleets are seperated in "A" and "B" with the "A" group featuring several national champions and Allison Jolly the 1988 olympic gold medal winner. The "B" fleet will give some of our newcommers an oportunity to measure their skills.

The race is open to all Lake Mission Viejo members, but if you would like to be scored also under the 1992 Coast Cup Series, please contact Horst Weiler.

March 29 - Where have all the Sailor's gone Regatta

This is the fist of the popular Pizza Sail's. This regatta and the complimentary Pizza get-together after the race is open to all Lake Mission Viejo members. Rent or bring your own sailboat. September 13 - Endless Summer Regatta This is the 5th and last Pizza Sail sponsored by the Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club.

October 4 - 15th Annual Lake Mission Viejo Regatta

This is the high-light of our sailing season and always has a super turnout.

Mark this date in your calender. Registration is from 10:30 to 12:00, Skippers Meeting at 12:30 and white flag at 1pm.

5 divisions from Novice to Advanced will compete for the top sailing spots at Lake Mission Viejo. Snacks and refreshments will be provided during the awards presentation after the race at the club house. This race will be video-taped and shown after the race.
